## **REVIEW:**

- A. John's Question. Luke 7:15-20
  - 1) The spreading of the report about Jesus
  - 2) John is imprison and his disciples report these things to him.
  - 3) John calls two of them to take a question to Jesus.
  - 4) (Vs. 19) "Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?"
  - 5) Now, remember all that happened...
  - 6) What does this question infer?
    - a) Everything I <u>SAW AND HEARD</u> was wrong
    - b) Everything I **<u>BELIEVED</u>** was wrong
    - c) Everything I <u>HOPED FOR</u> was wrong
  - 7) If you were going through this, what would be your state of mind?
- B. John's Answer. . . . . . . . . . . Luke 7:21-23
  - 1) Go tell John the things you have seen and heard
  - 2) Jesus doesn't say 'Of course I am, don't you remember?'
    - a) Aren't there answers you wish you would get from God?
    - b) Should I keep going? Is it okay if I stop?

- 3) Jesus answer is not direct, but simply connecting what we <u>HEARD</u> with what <u>IS</u> not what we <u>EXPECTED TO BE</u>
- 4) It is easy for us all to **EXPECT** something to be, because we see it as **GOOD**
- 5) "Blessed is he who is not offended..."
- C. John and Elijah..... Matthew 9:1-15
  - 1) Both preached repentance and righteousness (holy living) not acceptance.
  - 2) John had baptism, Elijah had miracles.
  - 3) (Vs.11) "Why does your Teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?"
    - a) People with this attitude ask questions to accuse not become informed
    - b) And ask the wrong people
  - 4) Preachers of righteousness can leave a love of the people for a love <u>OF THE LAW</u>
  - 5) We leave <u>SERVING IN</u> ministry for <u>PROTECTING THE</u> ministry.
  - 6) We believe we are out in front, but actually we have <u>GONE AWAY</u>
  - 7) Remember John's response to the Pharisees at first?
  - 8) Now look at it in Vs. 14
- APPLICATION: When we leave behind the <u>LOVE FOR</u> people in our work / ministry, the <u>LOVE</u> <u>OF</u> our work / ministry will soon follow, along with its joy.
