REVIEW:

A. Leaving..... Hebrews 6:1-3

- 1) The beginning word of Christ
 - a) Principles - first words
 - b) Beginning - refers to “word” not “Christ.”
 - c) Leaving - an action which causes a separation
- 2) Let us go on to perfection...
- 3) Repentance from dead works (works before salvation)
- 4) Faith toward God (Faith for salvation)
- 5) Doctrine of baptism (Hebrews 9:10)
 - a) of Moses (1 Cor 10:2) Through the Red Sea
 - b) of Jesus (Matt 3:16) Stepped into public ministry; next phase of ministry
 - c) of the cup (Matt 20:22) Can you be baptized with the baptism that I will be baptized in?
 - d) of fire (Matt 3:11-12) Judgement to come
 - e) into Christ or new Birth (1 Cor 12:13) baptized into one body - invisible
 - f) into water (Acts 2:38) - visible
 - g) into the Holy Spirit (Matt 3:12, Acts 12:8) baptized into the power

- 6) Laying on of hands
- 7) Resurrection of the dead
 - a) New Testament has developed this teaching into being RESURRECTED FROM DEATH
- 8) Eternal judgement

B. Progressing..... Hebrews 6:3

- 1) Vs. 3 Williams - “And we will progress, if God permits.”
 - a) What is needed in order to progress?
 - b) REVELATION
- 2) Pay ATTENTION
- 3) Not hardening their hearts (Heb. 3:7-16)

C. Of Those Who Have Progressed. Hebrews 6:4-6

- 1) For it is impossible
- 2) If they fall away
- 3) Principles for moving on in other doctrines
 - a) Don’t just stay on one or two subjects
 - b) If you heard teaching on a topic, but don’t walk in it, you are not ready to move on.
 - c) Learn, Understand, Implement, Progress
 - d) Don’t fall back onto inferior understandings.

APPLICATION: When things get hard, we tend to go back to what we first knew, even if it is wrong.
