- 4) It is easy to fall into the thinking that if such a message comes, it speaks to my lack of faith, but Jesus never addressed a faith problem, only a potential one.
- 5) There is no problem with the change or the request as far as Jesus is concerned: There is only a problem of **FEAR**.
- 6) New information often brings **QUESTIONS**
- 7) From faith's point of view, the problem is never in what we **FACE** but always in what we **FEAR**
- 8) <u>FEAR</u> and <u>WORRY</u> are not afraid of the presence of God, but <u>FLEE</u> our faith in God.

- 10) Faith combats **FEAR** not **SYMPTOMS**
- Just because what you face doesn't change doesn't mean your faith is not working!
- C. Other People's Facts...... Mark 5:37-43
