REVIEW:

A. Entrenched Mark 5:25-26

- 1) Jairus has a plan he desires Jesus to follow.
PROBLEM PLAN PROCLAMATION
- 2) Jairus clearly stated his problem, and the woman's is also clearly laid out.
 - a) There is a difference between simply stating a problem you have...
 - b) And taking **OWNERSHIP** of it
- 3) This woman likely had defeated words in her past.
- 4) When she heard about Jesus (Luke 6:17-19)
- 5) Just because you hear it, doesn't mean it will do you any good. You must...
 - a) **Meditate** on it and develop **beliefs** in line with the truth
 - b) Then **proclaim** what you believe
- 6) Revelation comes, and she **DEVELOPS FAITH IN IT**
- 7) What you do with revelation when it comes to you develops what **IT CAN DO FOR YOU**
- 8) The more **ENTRENCHED** the problem is, the more **SUBSTANTIAL** our faith must be.

B. Substance Mark 5:26-28

- 1) **Say** -*legō* (λεγω) = To ask, bid, boast, call, describe, name, put forth, say, speak, tell, utter.
- 2) **BELIEF** is the confidence that something is true
- 3) **FAITH** is the action of that confidence
- 4) Just because we have prayed does not mean we have **ACTED**
- 5) The parts of this story the woman could do, **GOD WILL NOT DO**
- 6) CAUTION: Our inability to discern between the voice of God and the voice of our desires, does not **BIND GOD**. Only **FAITH IN HIS WORD** does.

C. Movement Mark 5:29-33

- 1) What action of Jesus is required here?
- 2) Why is the woman fearful?

APPLICATION: Confession is not just **SAYING SOMETHING REPEATEDLY**

It is a **PROCLAMATION** of what you have come to **BELIEVE**

Hope is **CREATED** by **HEARING** the promises in the Word.

Faith is **DEMONSTRATED** by **ACTING** on the truth of those promises.

Expectation is **GENERATED** by **DECLARING** how that promise will come to me.
