C. Spiritual Joy (strength)

- 1) Spiritual joy is based on and fueled by belief in and thinking on <u>THE PROMISES OF THE</u> **FUTURE**.
- 2) Natural joy is based on and fueled by thinking on THE THINGS WE SEE AND FEEL and the EXPECTATIONS WE DERIVED FROM THEM
- To take you down spiritually, the enemy only needs to divert your joy from WHAT GOD PROMISED to WHAT YOU SEE and FEEL
- 4) The difference between what you expect and what you believe will happen is small and not measurable by your mind or flesh, but discerned by your spirit.
