REVIEW:

- Problem..... Luke 7:11-12 A.
 - 1) They could be relatives, or those who cared about her, him, maybe both.
 - 2) "man" is inserted and though there is nothing in this word to infer man, boy, etc., the rest of the passage makes it clear.
 - 3) Son is $(\upsilon_1 \circ \varsigma)$ uios - mature one, not child
 - The man is very dead and has been long enough to 4) have been prepared for burial and it's preparations readied.
- - Weeping $(\kappa \lambda \alpha i \omega)$ = to mourn, weep, lament 1)
 - 2) There is a command here.
 - It may just be better **TO PUT ON SOMETHING** 3) that is right, then to be genuine in what is wrong.
 - You may be genuine in your words, thoughts, and 4) outward expressions, but God may be telling you to knock it off!
 - She could have said, "No Jesus, I'm not feeling that 5) today."
 - That expression won't fit with what WAS GOING 6) TO HAPPEN, only with what DID HAPPEN
 - 7) The inroad for Jesus to change the situation is **HER** HEARING and OBEYING HIS COMMAND

- 8) The power is not in her **DENYING THE** CIRCUMSTANCES, but in her OBEYING HIS COMMANDS
- C. Proclamation Luke 7:14-17
 - Did Jesus just pick up an attachment to this 1) situation with a widow and son He never met?
 - 2) If mere compassion give us the right to intervene, how many people that you know would be healed?
 - Presented = give to. The man was taken, Jesus took 3) him back and gave him to his mother.
 - It is stated that she was his mother, so how did Jesus 4) come to have something of him and "present" him back to his mother?
 - 5) Similar situation in 2 Kings 4:32-37
 - They saw a great prophet because of what they had 6) seen him do, not what they heard Him teach. It was WORKS, not WISDOM they valued.
 - Guess what word they use for risen? $(\epsilon \gamma \epsilon i \rho \omega)$ 7) $egeir\bar{o}$ - the same one Jesus used!
- APPLICATION: More seems to be needed than just compassion to open the door to divine healing.

There needs to be some openness of the spirit to receive from God.
