## **EPHESIANS - Our Heavenly Account Statement**

### "FLOURISHING IN THE WILL OF GOD"

#### Genesis 17:1 - 18:15

Lesson #21 April 20, 2022

#### **REVIEW:**

- A. What I Don't Understand . . . . . Genesis 17:1-27
  - 1) With the goal of getting thoughts and words aligned God changes his name, changing his conversations.
  - 2) God sends renewal, but how will it be received?
  - 3) Take my flesh plan and bless it!
  - 4) How does Abraham go from believing God, leaving his home for an unknown land, to laughing as God speaks His will and plan to Him?
  - 5) When he first heard God's plan it brought joy and expectation, but now doubts fill his mind when he hears it spoken.
  - 6) It's not that the plan was impossible <u>TO</u>
    <u>UNDERSTAND;</u> it was simply understood <u>AS</u>
    <u>IMPOSSIBLE</u>
  - 7) An alternative route that was easier to imagine as achievable was proposed.
  - 8) You can ask God to bless something extra, but not to take His blessing of what He planned!
  - 9) Though Abraham laughed at first, he set out to immediately act on what God said.
  - 10) Too often we waste time trying to <u>UNDERSTAND</u>

    <u>HOW GOD WILL DO HIS PART</u>, instead of just doing **OUR PART**

- B. What I do Understand . . . . . . . . . Genesis 18:1
  - 1) There is not that much time that passes here. Ch. 17 began when he was 99 years old and Isaac is born at age 100 (Ch.22)
  - 2) Once we get lined up with the will of God, **DOING** what we understand and **BELIEVING** what we don't, things can happen pretty quick.
  - 3) Before Chapter 17, Abraham was thinking and speaking things against the declared will of God.
  - 4) His change is made visible by the **WAY HE RESPONDS** in Chapter 18.
- C. Someone Involved Doesn't Understand . . Genesis 18:1-15
  - 1) This time Abraham excepts what God says without doubting, but Sarah does not.
  - 2) In the time between the visits Abraham increased his willingness to believe what he didn't understand, but Sarah did not.
  - 3) Is Sarah unimportant?
  - 4) God doesn't seem to need **EVERYONE IN FAITH,** just the **ONE HE IS WORKING** through.
  - 5) Examples:
  - 6) God knows when you laugh at His promises, even when you laugh by yourself in the tent!

# APPLICATION: To understand more of the will of God, <u>ACT ON</u> WHAT YOU DO UNDERSTAND

Not understanding **HOW** should not prevent you when you do understand **WHAT**
