- 3) **Submission** Carrying out the will and desires of another (without being demanded or watched)
- 4) Submission is an <u>ATTITUDE</u>: Obedience is an <u>ACT</u> (Isaiah 1:19 & Philippians 2:8)
- 5) Difference between Submission and agreement
 - a) If I agree with another I do what I do because it **SUITS ME**
 - b) If I submit to another I do what I do because it **SUITS THEM**
- 6) This command is **TO WIVES** not **HUSBANDS**
- 7) It is up to me to obey the commands given to me.
- 8) When I am submitted to more than one authority, the higher one takes precedence.
- 9) When I act in an unsubmissive manor I open the door to:
