REVIEW:

A. Bondservants. Ephesians 6:5

- 1) From *doulos* (δουλος) = a slave (literal or figurative, involuntary or voluntary; frequently, therefore in a qualified sense of subjection or subserviency.
- 2) Occurs 127 times in 119 verses
- 3) Other uses

Matthew 8:9, 10:24 13:27 18:23, 20:27, 22:3, 25:14, 21, 26, 30

John 8:34-35, Romans 1:1, 6:16-17 & 19-20

2 Timothy 2:24, Titus 2:9, James 1:1, 1 Peter 2:16, 2 Peter 2:19

Jude 1:1, Revelation 1:1 & 7:3

- 4) If we are going to be a bondservant to Jesus, we must be:
 - a) Submitted to His will (which means we look to know and understand it.)
 - b) Love as He loves us
 - c) Give up our will to His
 - d) Become devoted to Him to the disregard of our own interests.
- 5) How would you say you are doing in this check list?

B. Obedient Ephesians 6:5

- 1) Be obedient - same word as last weeks Vs. 1
- 2) Just as a child is to listen to those things spoken to them, we are to listen to and obey those over us.
- 3) If we are to be bondservants to Jesus, what kind of obedience do we model to Him?
- 4) Fear and Trembling
1 Corinthians 2:3 & Philippians 2:12
- 5) Sincerity of heart

C. Eye service Ephesians 6:5-9

- 1) Not with eye service, or doing what we do just when we are being watched or to be seen.
- 2) This is working just to please men instead of Jesus.
- 3) “But as bondservants of Christ...” we should be doing what God wills or desires from us.
- 4) Whatever we do is service to God and not just to men if **WE SERVE WITH THIS ATTITUDE**
- 5) Slave or free
- 6) Master are to be in a similar way to the servants or employees they have.
- 7) If threatening is something they are to give up, what do you think is expected **OF PARENTS** ?
- 8) How well do you work in a office where threatening abounds?
