REVIEW:

- A. Let's Make Amends Nehemiah 6:1-2
 - 1) The motivation behind the request to meet was the wall's completion.
 - 2) It would seem that since the opposition wasn't successful, a different tactic was attempted.
 - 3) Not everyone who speaks of their good intentions actually has them.
 - 4) Here is what's missing for Nehemiah...
- B. I'm Busy Right Now..... Nehemiah 6:3-9
 - 1) His answer is basically, "I can't because I'm busy."
 - 2) The answer is not changed despite the repetitive asking. To repeat a question would infer that...
 - 3) By not changing his answer, the change came on their part which revealed their concealed agenda.
 - 4) If we allow <u>FEAR TO</u> motivate us to trust or allow someone back in our lives, how can the <u>GOD OF</u> <u>LOVE</u> be the inspiration?
 - 5) People seeking true friendship understand trust is built. They want to build it with you and you with them.
 - 6) People who just want to move you don't have time for building, and their speech betrays it.

- 7) Since their goal is weakness, our prayer is for strength for the task (not against them.)
- 8) Letting the enemy become our focal point is letting the enemy set our agenda.
- C. Snake in the Grass. Nehemiah 6:10-14
 - Why Nehemiah goes is not revealed, but we can surmise Shemaiah was <u>TRUSTED</u>, <u>LOYAL</u> seen as <u>BENEFICIAL</u> for the project.
 - 2) A plan to preserve Nehemiah's life is asserted to stop a very certain assassination attempt, with urgency used to mask it's problems.
 - 3) Urgency can get us to <u>GO</u> where we wouldn't, <u>DO</u> what we shouldn't, <u>SENSE</u> what isn't, and <u>FEAR</u> what never was.
 - 4) How can we know if we should believe a report like this?
 - 5) Examples of Godly warnings.
 - 6) Examples of urgency used to lead to a wrong path.
 - 7) If you just except the fear, you may not hear God's leading.
 - 8) Shemaiah was not alone in speaking this, as the were other prophets and a prophetess.
